E67 (Yellow Declaration Form)	
Flag-Pole document Issued by USCBP	
On a <u>valid study permit</u> when applying for the work permit	
Studied full- time in Canada at <u>a designated institution</u>	
Applicants must apply for a work permit <u>within 90 days of receiving written confirmation</u> from the educational institution indicating that they have met the requirements for completing their program of study	
Provide original transcripts in a sealed envelope.	
<u>Processing Fee</u>	
Work Permit	\$155.00
Biometrics (if applicable)	\$85.00
