Thank you for your email correspondence to Citizenship and Immigration Canada's (CIC) Immigration Representatives mailbox.

When a candidate is invited to apply under the Provincial Nominee Program (PNP), it means that they have a province or territory nomination that has been validated by the nominating jurisdiction. Candidates of the PNP, however, are still required to meet the program requirements of **one** federal immigration program, either CEC, FSTP or FSWP. It is the responsibility of the processing office to determine which federal program the candidate meets.

We hope this information will assist you. Once again, thank you for your email and for your interest in Express Entry.
